Purpose:	The purpose of this monograph is to provide a review of new therapy to determine whether the reviewed drug should be made available on an open access basis to prescribers, require a clinical edit or require prior authorization for use.
Dosage Forms:	Each tablet of Active Fe contains 4mg vitamin B ₁ , 4 mg vitamin B ₂ , 20 mg vitamin B ₆ , 30 mcg vitamin B ₁₂ , 160 mg vitamin C, 400 IU vitamin D ₃ , 40 IU vitamin E, 20 mg niacin, 1250 mcg folic acid, 75 mg iron, 30mg magnesium, 20 mg zinc and 1 mg copper.
